An alumnus and ex-Principal Sarbeswar Hazarika mentioned the dearth of a well-equipped Boys' Hostel in the college and inquired about the steps taken by the college authority to procure adequate fund for that purpose. In reply, Debajit Saikia intimated the gathering that proposals have been sent to different funding agencies and their response is being awaited. Another exstudent Bharat Dutta offered his thanks to the college authority for holding various academic programmes in the college and expected their continuation in the days to come. Another ex-student and General Secretary Monoj Borah assured the college authority of his help and cooperation in organising any programme of academic, social and cultural importance in the college. Another alumnus and Ex-Principal of Namoni Majul Junior College Anil Borah reminisced about the mammoth role played by this institution in spreading higher education in the island and appealed to the people at the helm of affairs to undertake more such activities in the near future commensurate with the demands of time and assured the college authority of his cooperation during the upcoming NAAC's inspection of the college.

IQAC sitting Date: 27-02-2017

An emergency sitting of the IQAC was held today, the 27th of February, 2017 under the chairmanship of Dr Debajit Saikia, Principal. IQAC coordinator Apurbajyoti Hazarika said that the meeting was organised basically to decide on the future course of action in view of drastic changes in the assessment criteria of NAAC. Elaborating on the issue Mr Hazarika said that the SSR prepared in the current method could be submitted only upto 31 March, 2017, according to information available on NAAC website. He also expressed his regret over the wasted labour in preparing such a huge document as it was not likely to be submitted before 31 March owing to various administrative bottlenecks. Principal Saikia said that as the SSR could not be sent due to some compelling administrative issues, now it should be prepared in accordance with the new criteria. In reply Mr Hazarika said that the newer system was going to be more ICT-enabled and detailed information regarding this was being awaited. Any fresh work could be initiated only after getting full access to the information. Dr Debabhuson Borah said that the other activities of the IQAC should be carried on without any interruption. Debojyoti Khataniar focussed on the need for the various cells/committees to continue their activities. Prasanta Saikia stressed the importance of eliminating the minor faults in the administrative mechanism of the college, especially in case of data preservation. Principal Dr Saikia assured the house of his prompt action in respect of the issues discussed and requested the office bearers of the IQAC to prepare the SSR and other documents afresh in accordance with the criteria to be available on NAAC website.
