- B. The fee of nomination paper is Rs. 600/- (Rupees Six Hundred) only for two copies, which is not refundable.
- C. Candidates are not allowed to contest in more than one portfolio.
- D. No student is allowed to propose or support more than one candidate.
- E. The candidates and their proposers and supporters will have to submit their respective fee clearance receipts at the time of submission of nomination papers, failing which the nomination papers of the concerned candidates will be rejected outright.
- F. All the voters must show their identity card at the time of casting and uniform is compulsory at the time of voting.
- G. A candidate must submit his nomination only in a valid Nomination Paper issued against his own name.
- H. Only those students whose name appears in the roll of the college on 31.12.2021 can contest in the election.
- I. Candidates must submit an age-proof certificate.
- J. A student who himself is a candidate for any portfolio cannot be a proposer or supporter for a candidate for any portfolio.
- K. One time served as MCSU elected member, he/she will not be allowed to contest election for the next session.
- L. Candidate must submit his marksheets of all semester examination attested by the Principal.

Rules

- 1. Lyngdoh Committee Report will be strictly followed to conduct election.
- 2. Full time and regular students only can take part in the election (Without any back in any subjects).
- 3. For college Union Elections the age of the candidate should not exceed 22 years.
- 4. No irregular or private students can participate or be proposer/ supporter or participate in campaigning for any candidate.
- 5. No arrangement of any form of parties/ tea party should be made by contesting candidates.
- 6. No candidates can receive any political patronage.
- 7. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed poster, printed pamphlets, or any other printed materials for the purpose of canvassing. Candidates may utilize only hand-made poster for the purpose of canvassing. Even hand-made banners are not allowed to be used.
- 8. No employee of the college can participate in election campaigning.
- 9. No candidate should be involved in character assassination or exploit religion, language or culture of the other candidates.
- 10. Only a student of 5th semester can be a candidate for President & Vice-President.
- 11. Open campaigning will be allowed on stipulated date and time only.
- 12. Candidates having any criminal records will not be allowed to contest the election.
- 13. Students of degree classes (except 5th semester) only can be a candidate for General Secretary.
- 14. No meeting of students (except the one stated in 10 above) will be allowed to be held on the college campus during the period 07.01.2022 to 12.01.2022. However, under unavoidable circumstances a meeting can be held with due permission from the Principal and intimation to the Returning Officer.
- 15. One time served as MCSU elected member, he/she will not be allowed to contest election for the next session.

16. COVID protocol will be strictly maintained in the election period.
