An awareness programme on 'Sexual Harassment at Work Place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal)' was organized by Sexual Harassment (Prevention) Cell, Majuli College in collaboration with IQAC, Majuli College and Rural Women Upliftment Association of Assam (RWUAA) on 08/06/2022 at Keshabram Borah Auditorium, Majuli College. Mrs. Priyakhi Kakati, Centre Administrator of Sakhi, Majuli was invited as the Resource Person for the Programme. The programme was attended by Respected Principal, Majuli College along with the faculty members and the students of the college. The programme started with the speech of Dr. Debajit Saikia, Principal, Majuli College in which he mentioned about the innumerable sexual harassment cases faced by women during their academic life as well as work life. He said that the most saddening part of such cases is that 70 % of the cases never come to surface due to various social stigmas of the society. He stressed to the students that sexual harassment to women is a criminal offence, which should not be hidden and urged them to never think it as a stigma and to gain courage to come forward to complain about such incidents. After this, the resource person of the event Mrs. Priyakhi Kakati spoke a few words on some of the cases she came forward with in her life as the Centre Administrator of Sakkhi, Majuli. She said that most of the young women are sometimes unaware that they are being sexually harassed as they think such incidents are probable in workplaces. She said that the limiting physical boundary of any man on a woman needs to be understood well by the young women of our society, which is a major reason of organizing such awareness programmes.
