Action Taken Report

2018-19

IQAC persistently tried to boost up the overall quality of the College through a number of significant activities. As per the 'Plan of Action', IQAC organized **Disaster Management Capacity Building Programme** on 19th February, 2019 in collaboration with District Administration, Majuli. 103 students participated in this programme. An **Orientation Programme** on CBCS was organized by IQAC on May 20, 2019. Dr. Jiban Saikia, Assistant Professor, J.B. College conducted the programme as Resource Person, where 42 teachers of Majuli College participated. As CBCS, introduced by Dibrugharh University in 2018, was new to the teachers, the attempt was fruitful in rendering new insight on CBCS. IQAC also collaborated on the Second **Debendra Nath Goswami Memorial Lecture** which was held on 5th February, 2019. As chalked out in the beginning of the academic year, an Environment cell was formed under the guidance of IQAC and two outreach activities on environment awareness had been conducted by the cell in rural areas of the Majuli island. IQAC also took initiative in academic and intellectual stimulation in the institution. In this context, several proposals have been submitted to different funding agencies such as UGC, ICSSR, and ICHR etc. for organizing seminars and workshops.

2019-20

IQAC consistently tried to exercise some good practices in the college in the line of recommendations made by the NAAC peer team for quality enhancement of the institution. Keeping this aspect in mind, emphasis was laid on conducting a number of job and skill oriented short term courses. As a result, certificate courses on Mass Communication, Tourism, Mask-Making and Performing Arts had been introduced in a planned way. 01 Smart classroom and 01 Computer Laboratory were established in the college campus and 04 laboratories for science practical had been renovated with latest facility and technology. The process of registration of

the Alumni Association was initiated. Several programmes for career guidance of students were conducted. Though the Plan of Action initially designed and adopted by IQAC was not fully materialised for the Covid 19 outbreak in the last few months of the session, the activities of IQAC during the session claim promise.

2020-21

This session witnessed unprecedented devastation in all spheres of life due to the Covid 19 pandemic. The academic institutions were literally closed for several months. Despite such challenges, Majuli College conducted 01 FDP, 09 Webinars, and 6 online lectures as planned by and in collaboration with IQAC. RFID, Web OPAC were installed in the central library of the college. Several outreach activities were conducted by NSS unit, NCC unit and Adopted Village Committee of the college. IQAC organized a programme called A Walk to the Library to rejuvenate the academic atmosphere in the college after the first Covid wave.


2021-22

Considering the dearth of availability of important books of students in a remote area like Majuli, IQAC successfully organized the First Majuli College Book Fair from April 5th -8th, 2022. IQAC organized one Sahitya Akademi sponsored National Symposium on Contemporary Assamese Literature: A Critical Discussion on April 30, 2022. An Awareness Programme on Sexual Harassment at Workplace was conducted on June 8, 2022. 21 nos. MOUs had been



signed with different institutions and organizations. The college received **ISO certificate** during this year.
