# STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT (SESION 2020-2021)

Due to Covid-19 pandemic, the college remained closed from May 2021 to September 2021. A few students have submitted their feedback reports and we analysed their reports. A total of 239 forms were received from the students. Regarding the General Aspects of the college feedback was sought on a Yes/ No basis while in other queries it was on a 5 point scale (1 for low agreement to 5 for high agreement). The analysis of the feedback reveals the following.

#### A. General aspects:

- 1. Almost 100% of the students are aware of the attendance policy of the college.
- 2. 99.1% of the students reported that they keep their parents informed about their academic progress. The rest 0.9% answered in the negative.
- 3. 7.3% of the students said that they faced ragging while 92.7% said they did not.
- 4. Almost 70.6% of the students participated in cultural activities in the college and elsewhere.
- 5. 98.3% of students participated in observation of days of National Importance.
- 6. Only 96% of the respondents agree that the college carry out cleanliness drives.
- 7. A meagre 31.3% of the students actively participate in NSS/NCC programmes.

#### F. About Laboratory Session:

Students having practical subjects responded to queries regarding laboratory session. The score corresponding to the queries was calculated and averaged as follows:

a)	Usefulness of materials provided in the laboratory	: 74%
b)	Effective demonstration of the practical session	: 80.9%
c)	Availability of laboratory equipment	: 77.8%
d)	Purpose and outcome of lab experiments	: 82.8%
e)	Learning level of students from hands-on equipment	: 77.3%

#### Suggestions:

On the basis of this analysis would like to put forward the following suggestions to the college authority vis-a-vis the Governing Body of the college.

- a) Since about 7.3% students have reported that they face some sort of ragging, proper steps should be taken to strengthen the Anti Ragging Cell of the college.
- b) The participation of students in NSS/ NCC is not satisfactory. The NSS and NCC wings of the college need to encourage the students to participate in these activities.
- c) Laboratory facility for the science subjects should be fortified.
