Gender Audit: An Introduction

About the College

Majuli College is situated in Majuli island, Assam, India. The largest river island in the world which is situated the river Brahmaputra was declared as a district in 2016. The island is connected to its nearby city Jorhat through ferry services. The island is known as a cultural hub of Assam. In the recent years there has been phenomenal spurt in the communication and transportation system of this island and its tourism sector also has got a boost.

Majuli College is one among the leading higher education institutions in the island district. Established on September 17, 1962 with a sacred mission of illuminating the riverisland with the beacon of education, Majuli College is the premier institution of higher education situated at Kamalabari in Majuli, the only island district of Assam. Affiliated to Dibrugarh University, Majuli College has been imparting education at the Under Graduate level in both Arts and Science streams. While the Arts stream has been functioning since inception, the Science stream was started in the year 1978 and it came under Deficit Grants in Aid system in 1986. Presently, the college has 10 (ten) departments in Arts stream and 5 (five) departments in Science stream. Offering both Higher Secondary and Degree courses to about 1400 students per year, Majuli College is the first college in the island which has both Arts and Science streams. The college offers P.G. courses in Distance Learning Mode under Dibrugrah University and U.G. and P.G. courses in various subjects under Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University. Other than these, the college offers vocational courses for the benefit of the students in Tourism, Journalism, Computer Applications, Performing art and Mask Making.

GENDER AUDIT

What is gender audit?

The gender audit is an attempt to study whether the college has good gender balance. It tries to see whether college follows governmental roles, policies and actions formulated for up-gradation of women in society. A gender audit would pay attention to different issues such as: the status of gender equality in their policy and decision-making structures, organizational culture and processes as well as to gather staff's perceptions, understanding and behaviours towards the issue.

Definition and purpose

Gender audits allow organisations 'to set their own houses in order, and change aspects of the organisational culture which discriminate against women staff and women "beneficiaries". As a method for gender mainstreaming, gender audits help organisations identify and understand gender patterns within their composition, structures, processes, organisational culture and management of human resources, and in the design and delivery of policies and services. They also help assess the impact of organisational performance and its management on gender equality within the organisation. Gender audits establish a baseline against which progress can be measured over time, identifying critical gender gaps and challenges, and making recommendations of how they can be addressed through improvements and innovations.

Although there is no standard approach for carrying out a gender audit, international organisations use two main approaches: participatory gender audit and the gender integration framework. A gender audit usually includes two dimensions.

An internal audit. This dimension refers to how much an organisation fosters gender equality internally within its organisational, managerial structure and internal work, and whether these contribute to gender equality in the organisation. An internal gender audit monitors and assesses the relative progress made in gender mainstreaming, contributes to capacity building and collective organisational ownership for gender equality initiatives, and sharpens organisational learning on gender.

An external audit. This dimension aims to assess to what extent an organisation mainstreams gender in its policies, programmes, projects and services in terms of content, delivery and evaluation. External gender audits evaluate to what extent gender integration fosters the inclusion of, and benefits to, women and men involved in or affected by the organisation's policies, programmes, projects or services provided.

When applied to policies, programmes, projects or services, a gender audit starts by exploring to what extent gender equality is mainstreamed in high-level policy objectives and priorities, and further assesses to what extent policy intentions are actually carried out in specific initiatives (e.g. programmes, projects, services). At the planning level, a gender audit analyses whether there are gender-specific objectives or if gender is mainstreamed in the general objectives of the policy in order to guarantee that they contribute to close gender gaps, ensure that women and men benefit equally or in accordance with their gender needs and that inequalities are not perpetuated. Similarly, a gender audit goes on to analyse how gender is mainstreamed into the implementation phase of the policy, programme or project. Finally, a gender audit of the monitoring and evaluation phase investigates whether targets and indicators include a gender perspective both in terms of sex-disaggregated data and progress towards gender equality.

Constitution of Gender Audit Committee

The gender audit has been conducted under the initiative of women cell Majuli college. The executive committee of the women cell has been assigned the duties for conducting the audit having the principal as adviser.

Gender Sensitive Features

Gender sensitivity refers to an attempt to encounter and accept people without presumptions. Gender sensitive approach aims at opening, reconstructing and broadening expectations and behavioural models related to gender. Gender sensitive structures respond equally to men and women's specific interests without any presumption based on outdated views.

The institution was established at a time in the early sixties when the issue of gender was not much of a concern especially in a remote region like ours considering the time when it was set up. Obviously when gender became a major parameter for institutional governance, the institutional leadership stepped forward. Although it cannot be said perfect but a general infrastructural survey does reflect the real picture. An Audit of gender sensitive features in the Institution yielded the following notable points. A physical verification was made about the nature of the gender sensitive features within the Campus. The following features were found present.

- ✓ Basic sanitation facility in the form of separate toilets for the students and staff is provided in the Administrative office, the Departments and the Hostels.
- ✓ Although in some Departments separate toilets for male and female faculty was not there.
- ✓ There is an Internal Complaints Committee.
- ✓ The hostels for girls are secured with collapsible gates, 24 hours security personnel and a full time warden.
- ✓ There are CCTV monitoring devices installed at different locations within the campus especially within the Library and major gates.

Objectives of Gender Audit-

- The institute shall take effective measures for safety and security of all gender.
- There must be accessible, active, unbiased and confidential Grievance Redressed Cell
- There shall not be any kind of discrimination on the basis of gender

- ➤ To develop and enhance the self- confidence and self esteem of girl students, women faculty and staff in the college.
- ➤ Overall personality development programs shall be organized, which will develop confidence in the members of the institution.
- ➤ To protect girl students from eve teasing and for the same posters to be exhibited at focal places in and around the college.
- > To establish good gender balance in decision-making processes in all areas of the college activities.
- ➤ To foster gender equality on all aspects of college community.
- To see the work and capacity for prevention of sexual harassment at the college.
- Organizing programme to built confidence and leadership qualities in the girl students.
- ➤ To join hands with IQAC, Anti-ragging committee and discipline committee and internal complaint committee for creation of gender sensitization.
- > To create social awareness about the problems of women and gender discrimination in particular.
- ➤ The Audit would enable the organization to identify the impact of gender relations on their agency's culture, processes programs and organizational performance and vice versa.

Gender wise distribution of staff in the College

The college was established in early sixties when the issue of gender was not much of a concern especially in a remote area like our place. When gender becomes a major parameter for institutional governance, the institutional leaders stepped forward taking steps to ensure gender equality.

Majuli College initiates the following gender sensitive measures-

- ➤ Basic sanitization facility in the form of separate toilets for the students and staff is provided the college. Separate toilets for male and female faculty are available.
- ➤ Electronic surveillance through CCTV cameras covering the strategic locations of the college campus.
- > Timings for entry and exit into hostels

- ➤ Grievance Redressed Cell, Anti ragging committee, anti sexual harassment cell etc are constituted in the college.
- ➤ Grievance Redressed Cell has been addressing all kinds of students' Grievances and various issues in the campus.
- ➤ Warden reside inside the campus for easy approachability during emergencies
- ➤ Girls are also sensitized about safety & Security precaution
- ➤ No vendor / visitor should be allowed in without entry in the register.
- > Suspicious movement of any person will be reported immediately.
- ➤ Various gender sensitization programmes were organized such as The female students of the college are immensely benefited from this to address their personal and psychological issues.

Gender Balance within the Institution

Gender balance means the existence of a fair ratio of male and female representation within the institution in terms of number of students in the various programmes as well as within the staff structure. The rationale is that traditionally women have lesser access to resources and opportunities due to the social structures which act as inhibitors to access.

Gender equity requires that girls and women be provided with a full range of activity and program choices that meet their needs, interests and experiences. Therefore, some activities may be the same as those offered to boys and men, some may be altered, and some may be altogether different. Our college always concentrates on student's academic performance along with their overall personality development. Observing gender equality, the girls are provided with various facilities. Lectures of eminent personalities are held on various topics to develop their personality. Total 10 different programs were organized in the last five years to make the girls aware of their rights and responsibilities.




Figure - 2 Gender wise details of Teaching faculties in Majuli College




Figure-2 Gender wise details of Non-teaching faculties in Majuli College




Figure-3 Gender wise details of students in Majuli College

In the year 2017-18 out of 826 students, the total number of girls students were 372 (45%) against 454 (55%) boys. In 2018-19 out of 893 students 390 (44%) were girls and 503(56%) were boys. In the year 2019-20 out of 872 students 411 (47%) were girls and 461(53%)were boys. In the year 2020-21 out of 919 students 419 (46%) were girls and 500 (59%)were boys. In the year 2021-22 out of 898 students 406 (45%) were girls and 492(45%) were girls.

- ➤ Introduce self- employment training in different subjects.




Figure 6- On 30th January 2022, a set of Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine and Sanitary napkin Incinerator Machine is installed in the Girls' Common Room, Majuli College.












Figure 3- 24 hours CCTV cameras in the Campus










Figure 4- 24 hours CCTV cameras in the Campus




Figure 6- Girls' common room




Figure 8- Indoor games equipment for girls at girls' common room




Figure 9- Display for the awareness on Sexual Harassment




Figure 14- Medical facility at College campus








Figure 15- Separate washroom for female faculties at teacher's common room
