






Figure- Use of LED Bulb


























Figure - Ramp at the entrance of Department of Chemistry and Physics










Figure- Ramp at the entrance of Administrative Building




Figure - Ramp at the entrance of A.C. Goswami Library




Figure - Hand rails in stairs at Administrative Building








Figure - The most convenient desk/bench pair reserved for disabled student in the classroom










Figure - Wheel chair facility for disabled person
