Subject : Implementation of Reservation Policy in admission and appointment.

Sir,

In continuation to this office letter No.F.21-2/2015 (CU) dated 23.03.2016 (copy enclosed) regarding the policy of reservation in admissions and appointments, I am directed to inform you to implement the reservation policy in admissions and appointments as under :-

- (i) University may follow the reservation policy in admissions in all courses as per provisions contained in the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006 (Gazette notification dated 04.01.2007) and as amended in 2012 (Gazette notification dated 20.06.2012). A copy of each of the CEI Act 2006 and Amendment Act, 2012 is enclosed for ready reference.
- (ii) For reservation policy in appointments of Non-Teaching staff, university may follow the quantum of reservation in Group 'C' and erstwhile Group 'D' posts as per instructions issued by DoPT Order No.36011/6/2010-Estt.(Res.) dated 25th June, 2010 (copy enclosed). For reservation in Group 'A' and Group 'B' posts, the reservation for SC is 15%, for ST is 7.5% and for OBC, reservation in direct recruitment is 27%.
- (iii) In teaching positions, reservation for SC is 15% and for ST is 7.5% at all three levels i.e. Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor. However, 27% OBC reservation in teaching positions is applicable at the level of Assistant Professor only.

**Subject: Revised Budget Estimates for 2015-2016 under Non-Plan of Central Universities –
regarding point wise reservation roster.**

Sir,

This is in reference to the discussion on Revised Budget Estimates for 2015-2016 held on 1st March, 2016 to 3rd March, 2016 in the UGC office. In this regard, I am directed to inform you that it has been observed that some of the Central Universities has not maintained the point wise reservation roster. Therefore, it is to inform you to frame the point wise reservation roster as per rules framed by the Govt. of India. Further, it is also to inform you that as per instructions of Govt. of India/UGC, the educational institutions receiving grant-in-aid from Central Government have to follow the prescribed percentage of Reservation i.e. 15% for SCs, 7% for STs and 27% in OBCs in the matter of teaching and non-teaching posts as well as in admissions to various courses except Minority educational institutions under Article 30(1) of the Constitution. The Central Universities are receiving 100% grant from the Central Government/UGC and they have to follow the Reservation Policy of the Government of India for SCs/STs in toto i.e. 15% for SCs, 7% for STs and 27% for OBCs in the matter of teaching and non-teaching posts as well as in admissions to various courses/degrees.

As per instructions of UGC, all the Central Universities have to maintain/provide the reservation for SCs/STs in teaching positions at all levels i.e. Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor and OBC reservation at Assistant Professor only.

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 3rd January, 2007, and is hereby published for general information:—

THE CENTRAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS
(RESERVATION IN ADMISSION) ACT, 2006

No. 5 of 2007

[3rd January 2007.]

An Act to provide for the reservation in admission of the students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes of citizens, to certain Central Educational Institutions established, maintained or aided by the Central Government, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

Enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006. Short title.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

Definitions.

(a) "academic session" means the period in a calendar year, or a part thereof, during which a Central Educational Institution is open for teaching or instruction in any branch of study or faculty;

(b) "annual permitted strength" means the number of seats, in a course or programme for teaching or instruction in each branch of study or faculty authorized by an appropriate authority for admission of students in a Central Educational Institution;

(c) "appropriate authority" means the University Grants Commission, the Bar Council of India, the Medical Council of India, the All India Council for Technical Education or any other authority or body established by or under a Central Act for the determination, coordination or maintenance of the standards of higher education in any Central Educational Institution;

(d) "Central Educational Institution" means—

(i) a university established or incorporated by or under a Central Act;

(ii) an institution of national importance set up by an Act of Parliament;

(iii) an institution, declared as a deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, and maintained by or receiving aid from the Central Government;

(iv) an institution maintained by or receiving aid from the Central Government, whether directly or indirectly, and affiliated to an institution referred to in clause (i) or clause (ii), or a constituent unit of an institution referred to in clause (iii);

(v) an educational institution set up by the Central Government under the Societies Registration Act, 1860;

(e) "faculty" means the faculty of a Central Educational Institution;

(f) "Minority Educational Institution" means an institution established and administered by the minorities under clause (1) of article 30 of the Constitution and so declared by an Act of Parliament or by the Central Government or declared as a Minority Educational Institution under the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004;

(g) "Other Backward Classes" means the class or classes of citizens who are socially and educationally backward, and are so determined by the Central Government;

(h) "Scheduled Caste" means the Scheduled Castes notified under article 341 of the Constitution;

(i) "Scheduled Tribes" means the Scheduled Tribes notified under article 342 of the Constitution;

(j) "teaching or instruction in any branch of study" means teaching or instruction in a branch of study leading to three principal levels of qualifications at bachelor (undergraduate) masters (postgraduate) and doctoral levels.

3. The reservation of seats in admission and its extent in a Central Educational Institution shall be provided in the following manner, namely:—

(i) out of the annual permitted strength in each branch of study or faculty, fifteen per cent. seats shall be reserved for the Scheduled Castes;

(ii) out of the annual permitted strength in each branch of study or faculty, seven and one-half per cent. seats shall be reserved for the Scheduled Tribes;

(iii) out of the annual permitted strength in each branch of study or faculty, twenty-seven per cent. seats shall be reserved for the Other Backward Classes.

4. The provisions of section 3 of this Act shall not apply to:

(a) a Central Educational Institution established in the tribal areas referred to in the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution;

(b) the institutions of excellence, research institutions, institutions of national and strategic importance specified in the Schedule to this Act;

Provided that the Central Government may, as and when considered necessary, by notification in the Official Gazette, amend the Schedule;

(c) a Minority Educational Institution as defined in this Act;

(d) a course or programme at high levels of specialisation, including at the post-doctoral level, within any branch of study or faculty, which the Central Government may, in consultation with the appropriate authority, specify.

5. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in clause (iii) of section 3 and in any other law for the time being in force, every Central Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority, increase the number of seats in a branch of study or faculty over and above its annual permitted strength so that the number of seats, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes, is not less than the number of such seats available for the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of this Act.

(2) Where, on a representation by any Central Educational Institution, the Central Government, in consultation with the appropriate authority, is satisfied that for reasons of financial, physical or academic limitations or in order to maintain the standards of education, the annual permitted strength in any branch of study or faculty of such institution cannot be increased for the academic session following the commencement of this Act, it may permit by notification in the Official Gazette, such institution to increase the annual permitted strength over a maximum period of three years beginning with the academic session following the commencement of this Act; and then, the extent of reservation for the Other Backward Classes as provided in clause (iii) of section 3 shall be limited for that academic session in such manner that the number of seats available to the Other Backward Classes for each academic session are commensurate with the increase in the permitted strength for each year.

6. The Central Educational Institutions shall take all necessary steps, which are required in giving effect to the provisions of sections 3, 4 and 5 of this Act, for the purpose of reservation of seats in admissions to begin in calendar year, 2007.

7. Every notification made under this Act shall be laid, as soon as may be after it is made, before each House of Parliament while it is in session, for a total period of thirty days which may be comprised in one session or in two or more successive sessions, and if, before the expiry of the session immediately following the session or the successive sessions aforesaid, both Houses agree in making any modification in the notification or both Houses agree that the notification should not be made, the notification shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be; so, however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done under that notification.

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 19th June, 2012, and is hereby published for general information:—

THE CENTRAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (RESERVATION IN ADMISSION) AMENDMENT ACT, 2012 [No. 31 of 2012]

[19th June, 2012]

An Act to amend the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006

It is enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Amendment Act, 2012. Short title.

2. In section 2 of the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), after clause (A), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:— Amendment of section 2

(A) "specified north-eastern region" means the area comprising of the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura and the tribal areas of Assam referred to in the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution;

(B) "State quota", in relation to a Central Educational Institution, means such seats, if any, not of the annual permitted strength in each branch of study or faculty as

are earmarked to be filled from amongst the eligible students of the State in which such institution is situated."

of section 3.

3. In section 3 of the principal Act, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

"Provided that the State seats, if any, in a Central Educational Institution situated in the tribal areas referred to in the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution shall be governed by such reservation policy for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes, as may be specified, by notification in the Official Gazette, by the Government of the State where such institution is situated."

Provided further that if there are no State seats in a Central Educational Institution and the seats reserved for the Scheduled Castes exceed the percentage specified under clause (i) or the seats reserved for the Scheduled Tribes exceed the percentage specified under clause (ii) or the seats reserved for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes taken together exceed the sum of percentages specified under clauses (i) and (ii), but such seats are—

(a) less than fifty per cent. of the annual permitted strength on the date immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act, the total percentage of the seats required to be reserved for the Other Backward Classes under clause (iii) shall be restricted to the extent such sum of percentages specified under clauses (i) and (ii) falls short of fifty per cent. of the annual permitted strength;

(b) more than fifty per cent. of the annual permitted strength on the date immediately preceding the date of commencement of this Act, in that case no seat shall be reserved for the Other Backward Classes under clause (iii) but the extent of the reservation of seats for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes shall not be reduced in respect of Central Educational Institutions in the specified north-eastern region."

4. In section 4 of the principal Act, clause (a) shall be omitted.

5. In section 5 of the principal Act,—

(a) in sub-section (1), for the words "number of such seats available", the words "number of such seats available or actually filled, whichever be less," shall be substituted;

(b) in sub-section (7), for the words "three years", the words "six years" shall be substituted.

6. In section 6 of the principal Act, for the figures "2007", the figures "2008" shall be substituted.

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I have the honour convey the decision of the meeting held on 16/08/2021 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam with the officials of Education Department in regards to admission in Class XI and Degree 1st year. The decisions in Higher Education Department are as follows :

1. The notification issued by the Director of Higher Education regarding 75% seats reservation for SEBA/AHSEC pass candidates in admission into class XI and Degree First year is to be withdrawn forthwith.
2. Candidates passing out from CBSE and SEBA or CBSE and AHSEC are to be treated at par in judging merit for admission into all educational institutions without any prejudice. All available seats in Colleges will be open for students of all CBSE, SEBA and AHSEC.
3. However, educational institutions are encouraged to increase seat capacity by 25% additional seats and these additional seats shall be reserved for the students from SEBA and AHSEC.
4. In view of the increase numbers of students passing Class X and XII examination this year resultant shortage of seats, Colleges are advised to run morning/evening shifts.
5. Teachers engaged in these additional shifts are to be remunerated with a maximum limit of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) as an incentive.

In this connection, I have the honour to inform you that regarding enhancement of seat capacity of U.G. level course in the institutions by 20% and reservation of 75% seats in Degree Courses of the Govt. and Provincialised Colleges for students of ASHEC as communicated vide this office letter No.PC/HE/Misc./42/2020/35, dtd.07/08/2021 is hereby withdrawn. The other contents of the letter will remain same.

With reference to the subject cited above, I have the honour to forward herewith the Govt. O.M. No.AHE.250/2014/1, dated 05-06-2014 in connection with uniform Policy of Admission of Students into the Colleges in different Streams of Government and Provincialised Colleges of Assam.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub : Uniform Policy of Admission of Students into the Colleges in different Streams of Government and Provincialized Colleges of Assam.

The State Government has been actively considering the need for making Uniform Policy of admission of the students into the Degree Colleges in different streams of Government and Provincialized Colleges of Assam. Accordingly, following instructions / guidelines are issued for compliance by every college authority with immediate effect, i.e., from the current year 2014-15.

- i) Henceforth, the college authority should declare the numbers of seat to be offered for admission in each stream at the beginning of the Session.
- ii) Admission Notice is to be published in the local Daily Newspapers, both English and Assamese, or in Notice Board of the colleges indicating the category-wise total number of seats to be offered for admission.
- iii) The admission should be on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination subject to Government Reservation Policy.

iv) A maximum 5% of the seats may be earmarked as per break up given below for outstanding Sports Persons / NCC Cadets / proficiency in cultural activities / wards of the employees of the colleges, etc.

(a) 2% for Sports Persons of sports recognized by IOA/SAI and

(b) also have represented District/ State, etc.

(b) 1% for wards of employees of the college and

(c) 1% for NCC/Scouts/ Guides.

(d) 1% for the students with achievements in cultural activities.

These seats are to be filled on the basis of merit list of students concerned in each category. The detailed guidelines for filling up of these seats may be finalized by the Governing Bodies of the Colleges.

v) There shall be no discretionary Quota of Seats to be filled up by the Principal or any other authority.

vi) No seats will be offered for admission by the College Authorities against donations to the college fund.

vii) The Principal of the College will notify the closure of admission in any academic year and publish category-wise the names of students with marks etc. who are admitted to the college in the Notice Board / College Website. A copy of the same will also be submitted to the Director, Higher Education for information.

The above instructions should be followed scrupulously by all concerned starting with the admission for the academic year 2014-15. Any deviation from the above will be viewed seriously and will invite disciplinary actions.



I am directed to say that it has been decided by the Government that there shall be reservation of seats for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (including More Other Backward Classes) in Technical, Medical etc. Institutions under Education, Agriculture, Veterinary, Health & Family Welfare, Labour & Employment etc. Departments at the same percentage at which vacancies are reserved for them in appointments to public services. It is also hereby made clear that the reservation is in addition to the seats secured by members of these communities on the basis of merit. This may please be noted.

You are aware that under the Assam Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Act, 1978 and under the personnel Department O.M. NO. ASP-338/83/14 dated 4-1-1984, the reservation in favour of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes is as follows:-

Members of Scheduled Caste	.. 7%
Members of Scheduled Tribes (Plains)	.. 10%
Members of Scheduled Tribes (Hills)	.. 5%
Members of Other Backward Classes (including More Other Backward Classes)	.. 13%

It is requested that necessary modification of rules, orders, etc., governing allotment of seats for admission to technical, medical etc. institutions may be made accordingly to be effective from the 1984 session of these institutions. Attention of the Departments of Education, Health & Family Welfare, Agriculture, Veterinary, Labour & Employment in particular are drawn in this regard.

The above instructions should be scrupulously followed.

CHAPTER VI

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR PERSONS WITH BENCHMARK DISABILITIES

33 of 2009

31. (7) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Rights of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, every child with benchmark disability between the age of six to eighteen years shall have the right to free education in a neighbourhood school, or in a special school, of his choice.

Free education for children with benchmark disabilities.

(2) The appropriate Government and local authorities shall ensure that every child with benchmark disability has access to free education in an appropriate environment till he attains the age of eighteen years.

32. (1)

[REDACTED]

(2) The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission in institutions of higher education.

33. The appropriate Government shall—

Identification of posts for reservation.

(i) identify posts in the establishments which can be held by respective category of persons with benchmark disabilities in respect of the vacancies reserved in accordance with the provisions of section 34;

(ii) constitute an expert committee with representation of persons with benchmark disabilities for identification of such posts; and

(iii) undertake periodic review of the identified posts at an interval not exceeding three years.

34. (1) Every appropriate Government shall appoint in every Government establishment, not less than four per cent. of the total number of vacancies in the cadre strength in each group of posts meant to be filled with persons with benchmark disabilities of which, one per cent. each shall be reserved for persons with benchmark disabilities under classes (a), (b) and (c) and one per cent. for persons with benchmark disabilities under classes (d) and (e), namely:—

Reservation.

(a) blindness and low vision;

(b) deaf and hard of hearing;

(c) locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leg/arm/curd, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy;

(d) autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness;

(e) multiple disabilities from amongst persons under classes (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness in the posts identified for each disability.


Provided that the reservation in promotion shall be in accordance with such instructions as are issued by the appropriate Government from time to time.

Provided further that the appropriate Government, in consultation with the Chief Commissioner or the State Commissioners, as the case may be, may, having regard to the type of work carried out in any Government establishment, by notification and subject to such conditions, if any, as may be specified in such notifications exempt any Government establishment from the provisions of this section.

(2) Where in any recruitment year any vacancy cannot be filled up due to non-availability of a suitable person with benchmark disability or for any other sufficient reason, such vacancy shall be carried forward in the succeeding recruitment year and if in the succeeding recruitment year also suitable person with benchmark disability is not available, it may first be filled by interchange among the five categories and only when there is no person with disability available for the post in that year, the employer shall fill up the vacancy by appointment of a person, other than a person with disability.
