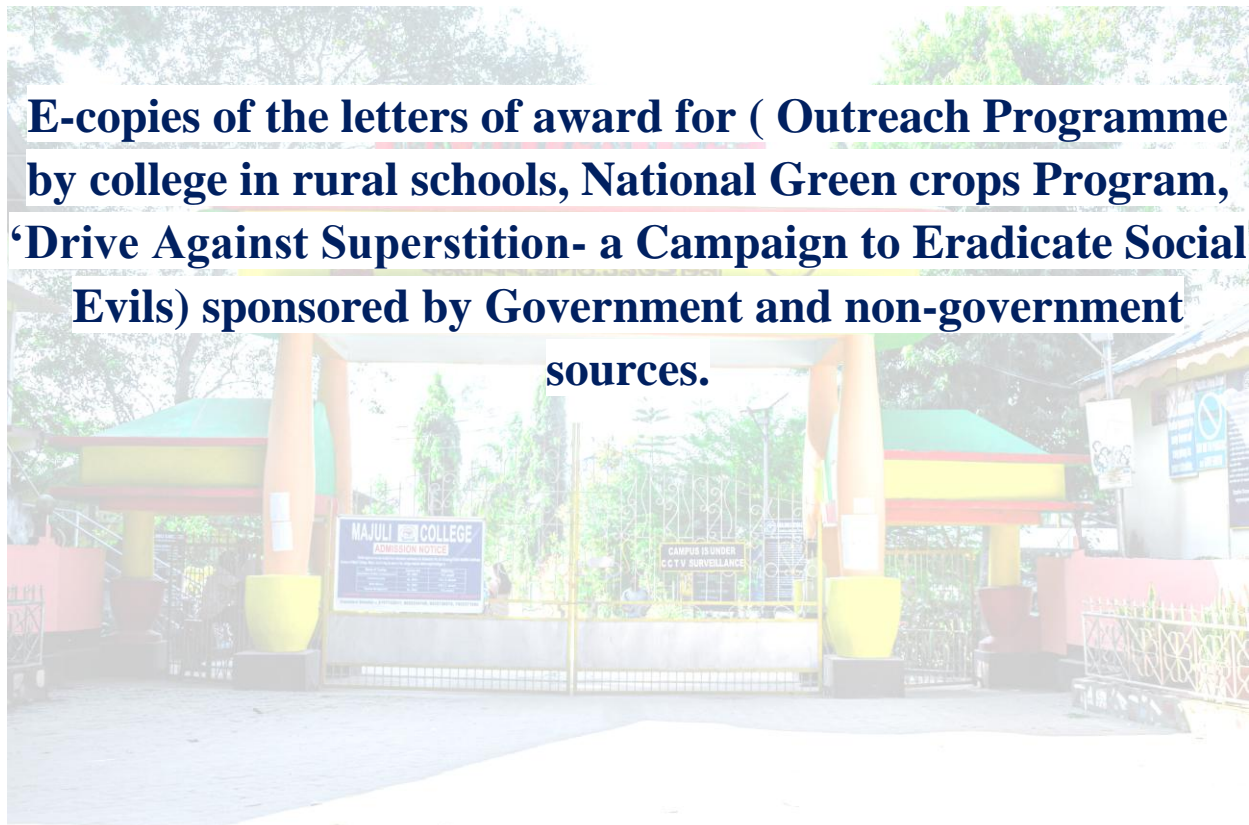





Dear Sir/Madam,





SANCTION ORDER

Sanction of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) is hereby accorded to each College Eco Club of Assam for conducting Eco-Club activities in 100 (one hundred) colleges under the project "National Green Corps Programme" supported by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Govt. of India and the full amount, i.e. Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) is hereby released as one time grant to each college for the year 2021-22 as per following terms & conditions

Terms & conditions:

- Sanction has been fixed at Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) per College Eco Club and released in full amount per college as one time grant to 100 College Eco-Clubs for the year 2021-22 (College Eco Club list: Annexure - I).
- The works as mentioned in Annexure - II, have to be completed within one year from the date of issue of this sanction Order. Further, minimum of 10 important tree species are to be planted within or outside the campus of the college & these should be properly maintained.
- Sanction amount shall be released to those College Eco Clubs who have submitted U.Cs, S.o.E's, Report etc for the FY 2020-21.
- Payments will be made to the respective Bank Accounts through RTGS only and necessary information will be communicated through e-mail.
- Amount sanctioned/ released to concerned college is meant for College Level Activities of National Green Corps Programmes only. No fund should be utilized for other purposes.
- All colleges has to utilize the sanctioned amount within stipulated time, failing which, the said amount is to be refunded to the "Director, ASTE Council" along with incurred bank interest.
- All concerned Principals have to conduct Eco-Club activities from time to time with active involvement of the In-charge Teacher of College Eco-Club, Teachers and Eco-Club members.
- All the Heads of colleges will have to submit Utilization Certificate (UC) & Statement of Expenditure (SoE) as per our UC format along with a Report and 5 photographs, video clippings, etc. to ASTE Council.
- Each Eco-Club shall display a Sign Board of 2.5ft height and 4ft width in safe and visible place in the college premises. A sample of the sign board is given below (Please ignore if already exists)

SANCTION ORDER

Sanction of Rs. 40,000.00 (Rupees forty thousand) only is hereby accorded to Majuli College for organizing awareness programme against superstitious beliefs like-witch hunting, snake bite, women health, agriculture, child lifting, fake news, etc. under the project "Drive Against Superstition-a campaign to eradicate social evils" supported by Science, Technology & Climate Change Department, Government of Assam. Amount earmarked for organizing awareness programme in five (5nos) different schools.

Terms & conditions:

1. Sanctioned amount Rs. 40,000.00 has been allotted to Majuli College, Majuli District of Assam for organizing all activities related to the superstitious beliefs which will be released through RTGS/ECS to your Bank Account.
2. You will have to utilize the sanctioned amount within two months, failing which, the said amount is to be refunded to the "Director, ASTE Council" along with accrued interest thereon.
3. You will have to ensure wide media coverage of the activities in their respective districts.
4. You will have to submit a set of (a) Utilisation Certificate (UC) (b) Statement of Expenditure (SoE) (c) Activity report and photographs taken at each schools along with supporting documents.
5. The UC along with all other relevant documents must be submitted to the Director, ASTE Council.

Activities to be conducted under The Project-Drive Against Superstition-A Campaign To Eradicate Social Evils

1. Organizing awareness programmes against superstitious beliefs such as- witch hunting, snake bite, black magic, women health, agriculture, child-lifting, etc.
2. Displaying scientific messages through banners, posters, etc.
3. Propagation of messages against superstitions through pamphlets, leaflets, hand-outs, etc.
4. Organizing awareness rallies, street plays, folk performances as drive against superstitious beliefs.
5. Conducting superstition theme based drawing competition, cartoon competition, etc among the students.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS AS PER DIRECTIVES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF ASSAM HAS TO BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED. Local administration should be involved for conducting the programmes.

If agreed, 80% of Rs. 40,000/- i.e. Rs. 32,000/- (Rupees thirty two thousand) only will be released as 1st Installment and the remaining 20%, i.e. Rs. 8000/- will be released after submission of U.C, S.O.E, Activity Reports and Photographs of the participants, etc.
