

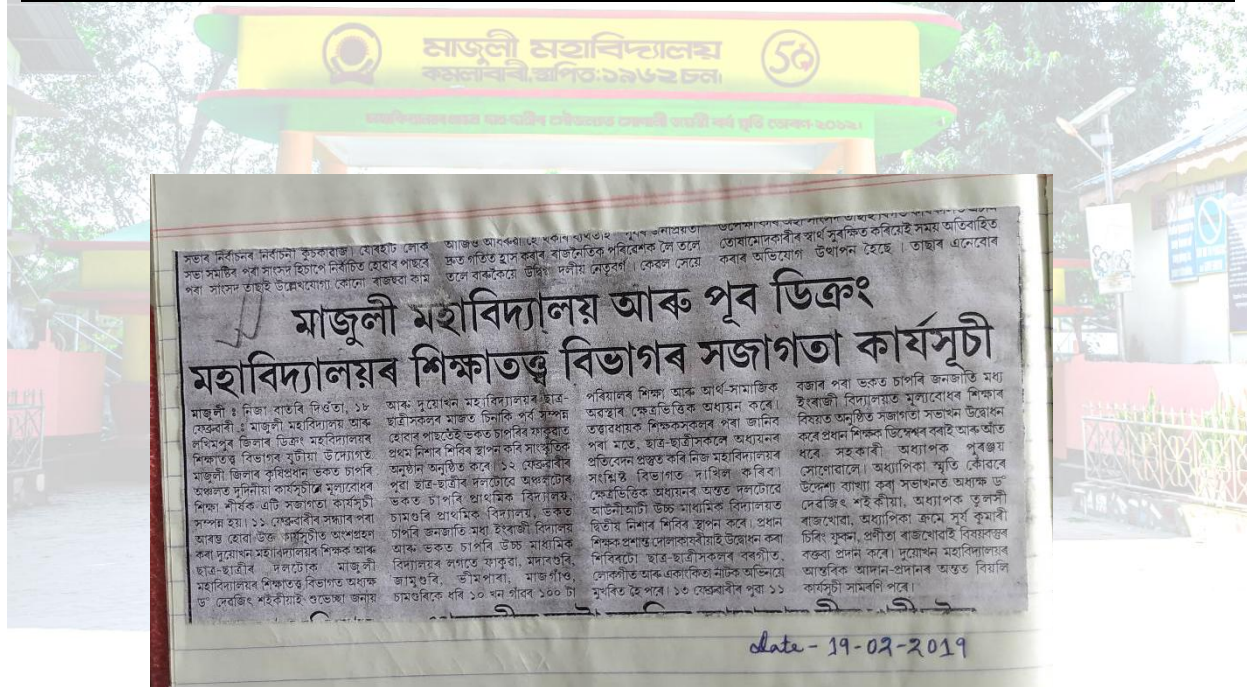


Fig: News paper cutting of the awareness program published on 18/02/2019







20. Construction of Bamboo Foot Bridge between Kamalabari Ferry Ghat Road and Khorahola Village under the funding of Rs. 20,000 by NSS Cell, Dibrugarh University

A Bamboo foot bridge was constructed between Kamalabari ferry ghat road and Khorahola village end by NSS unit of Majuli College. Around twelve number (12) of villages will be benefitted for the Bamboo foot bridge. After completion of construction of Bamboo foot Bridge, the distance has reduced to around 8-10 km to Kamalabari Ferry Ghat and also it is the shortest distance from Khorahola village to Kamalabar Charali. Many college students studying in Majuli college and school students studying in different schools of Majuli now can avail the bridge for their classes. Many farmers and vegetables sellers also can avail the bridge for running their small business and daily activities. This bridge will be highly beneficial to all the people inhabiting in that area during monsoon and flood time in Majuli.

- (1) Total Length of the Bridge: **32 meters**
- (2) Breath of the Bridge: **1.5 meter**
- (3) Number of Days required for completion of the Bridge: **9 Days (02.12. 2021- 08.12.2021 + 24.11.21 & 29.12. 2021)**
- (4) Number of Volunteers Involved in the Construction: **25**
- (5) Number of Villagers involved in the Construction: **09**

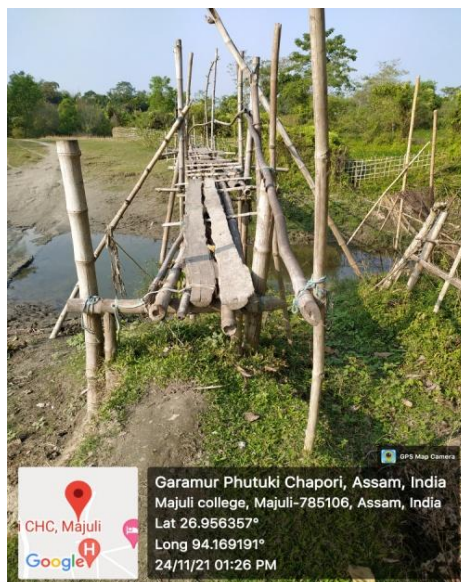


Figure-1: Before Construction of Bamboo foot Bridge







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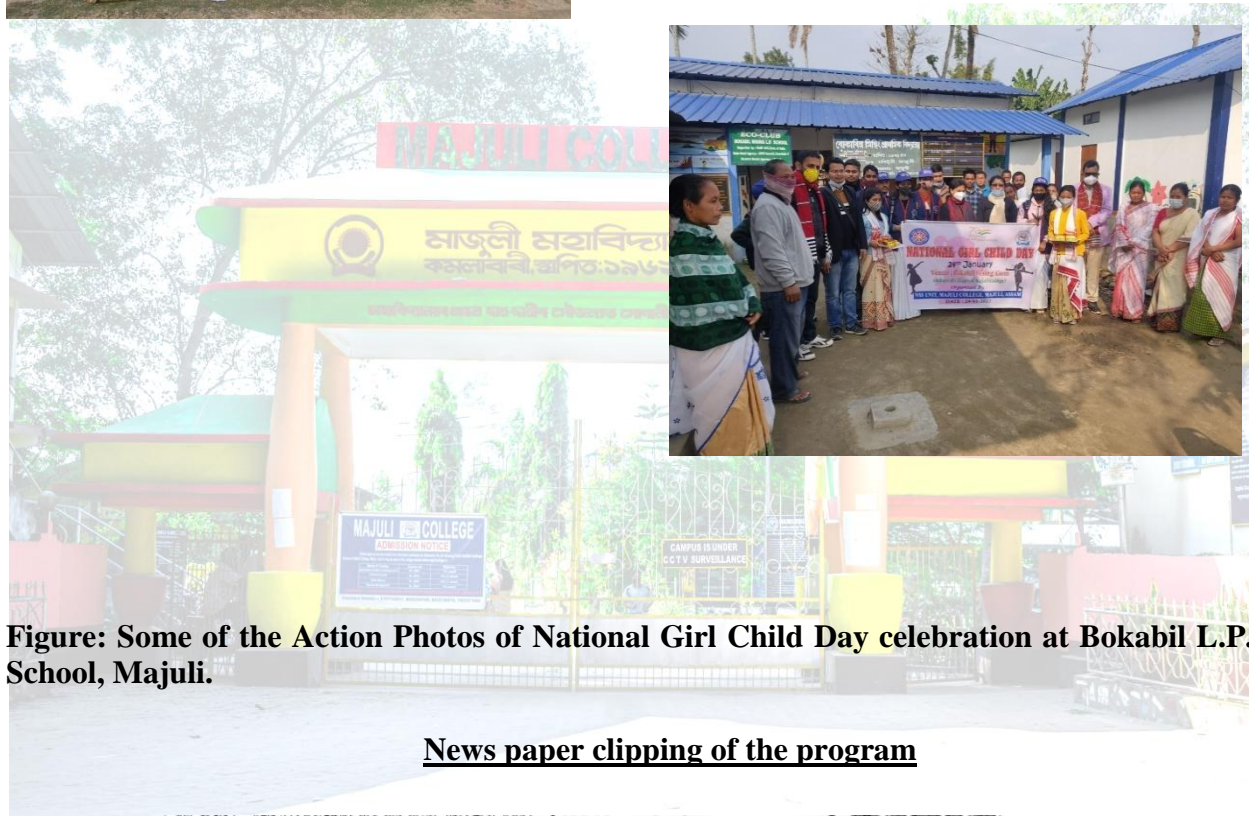


Figure: Some of the Action Photos of National Girl Child Day celebration at Bokabil L.P. School, Majuli.


42. Socio-economic Survey at Bokabil Mising Gaon on 27.01.2023 by NSS Volunteers


