The topic of the webinar was “Environmental Status of Majuli District and It's Conservation Strategies”. Sri Debajit Phukan, Co-ordinator, Megamix Nature Club, Dhakuakhana was the resource person of the webinar. The programme started at 12 noon with the welcome speech by Mrs. Indira Borah, Head of the Department, Botany, Majuli College. Then the webinar was formally inaugurated by Dr. Debajit Saikia, Principal, Majuli College. Dr. Juli Gogoi coordinator of the webinar, gave a brief introduction of the resource person and welcome him for his speech. He first explained about the biodiversity and its three components viz. ecosystem, species and genetic diversity. He mentioned about the interrelation and services of nature to the biodiversity. Biodiversity always depend on the richness of microhabitat, species diversity and density of habitat. The wetlands of Majuli is highly fertile and due to which habitat is diverse. Majuli is a hotspot for flora and fauna. Many rare and endangered avifauna species including migratory birds that arrive in the winter season. Environmentally Majuli island is evergreen. After elaborate explanation about the biodiversity status of Majuli he explains about the threats to biodiversity in this river island. He specially mentioned the biotic pressure created by human being which is very distinct along with natural calamities like soil erosion, flood etc.

According to him before 1950 Majuli was special hotspot of biodiversity but gradually it turned into a distinguished biodiversity location due to different human activities. At last he guided to adapt some techniques which are eco-friendly for the sustainability of the environment and the biodiversity.

- create and execute user-defined functions,

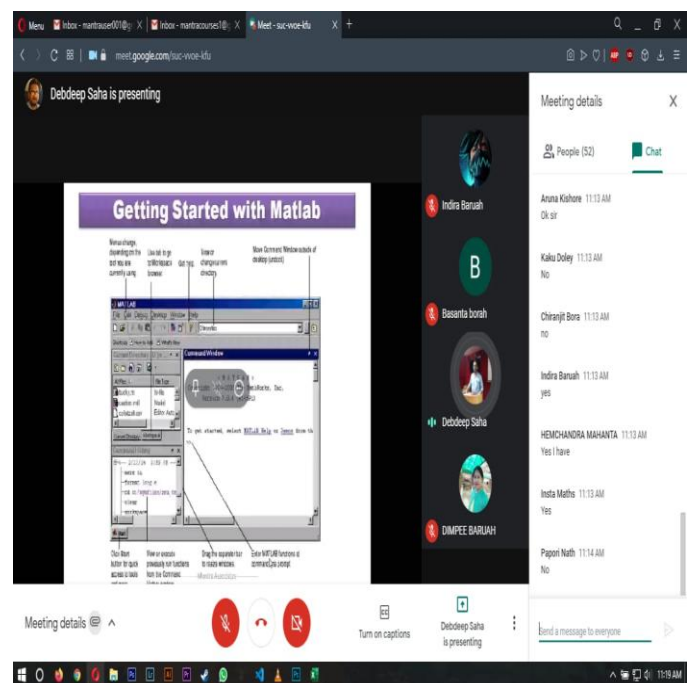
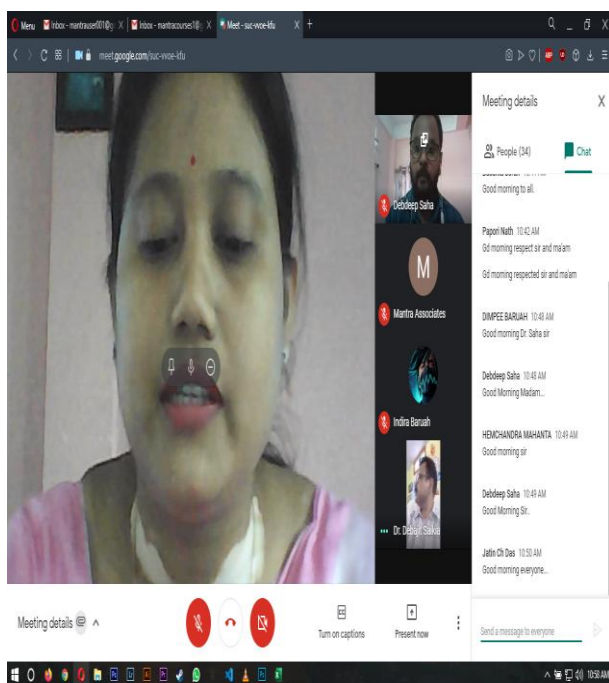
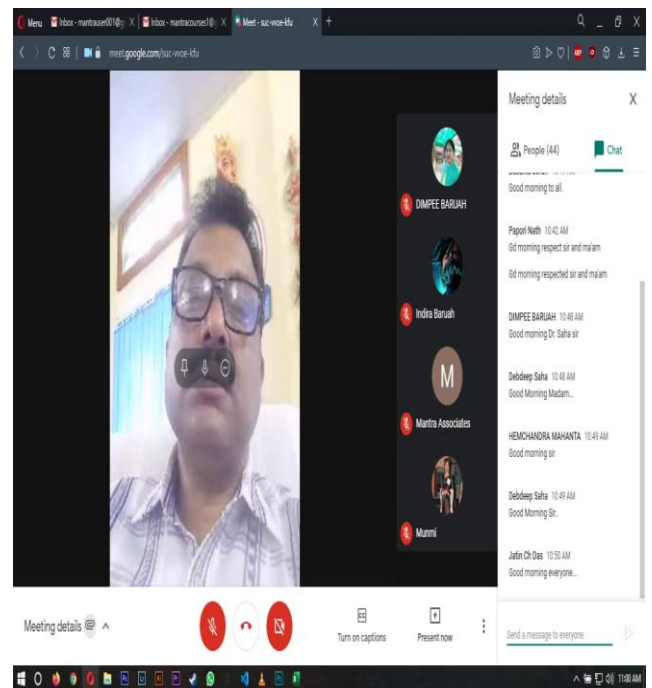
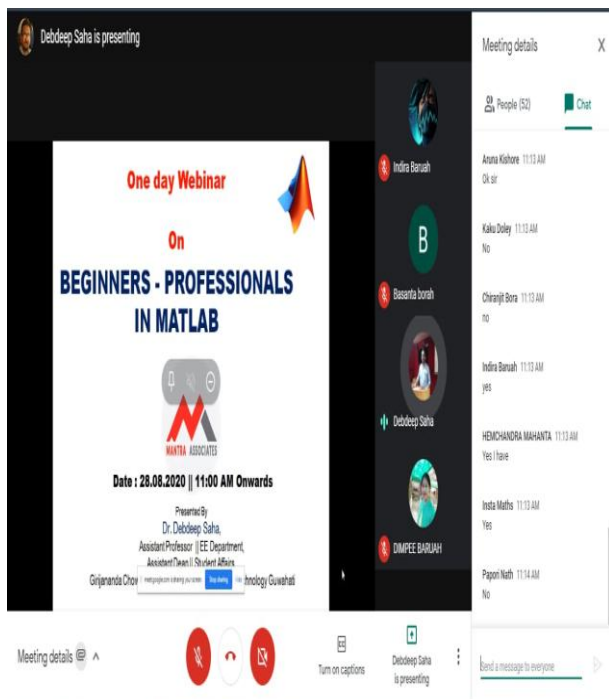

With the generous encouragement and support from the Principle, Majuli College, department of Political Science organized a national webinar on the topic “**The Changing Nature of Indo-China Relationship Under PM Narendra Modi**” on 24th August at 3:00 PM. Around 97 participants comprising of the students, research scholars and faculties of different colleges and universities participated in the webinar. The event started with an opening remark by Anamika Adhikari. She welcomes all participants and the Resource Person. She also gave a brief introduction of the Resource Person. The program was inaugurated by Dr. Debajit Saikia, Principal, Majuli College, wherein he extended his warm welcome to the participants and resource person of the webinar. He emphasized on the need of organizing webinars are so important so as to meet the ongoing situations, current requirements and standards in the field of higher education. He appealed to the entire faculty to work collectively for the academic development of the College. Lastly, he enumerated the importance of organizing this webinar on which is essential in improving the quality of higher education in the state which will help in

continuous quality improvement, in order to facilitate the institutions in order to take necessary initiatives and efforts for improving the quality of higher education in the state.

Afterwards, Dr. Jageswar Bora gave a detailed presentation on Indo-China relationship. In the initial part of his session, he briefed about the history of India and China relationship. He further highlighted that Narendra Modi is the only Prime Minister who has visited five times to China, three times as the CM of Gujarat and twice as the PM of India. He added that in the beginning India and China shared a very good relationship and Narendra Modi was a critique of US policies because on March, 2005 the then President of USA, George W. Bush refused to grant visa to Modi. He further added that Modi's belief that economic relationship between India and China will be a game changer is nothing but mere illusion as there is a huge gap in trade. He highlighted the fact that later on the relationship became bitter due to various domestic as well as international compulsions. The domestic complexities aroused due to the repeal of Article 370 and establishment of Jammu and Kashmir as Union Territory and in international sphere it is the unpredictable character of China for which Narendra Modi government gradually moved towards USA. He mentioned that the declaration of Modi about the closer relationship with USA adversely effected the Indo-China relationship. According to him, India's alliance with USA is one of the main factors behind China's aggression. Along with it, other factors such as, lack of consensus on international border, new Chinese claim on Indian Territory, the issue of Tibet, water dispute, China's increasing activities with Pakistan and China's reluctance on India's demand on permanent membership in UN Security Council are responsible behind the changing relationship between India and China. Later, Dr. Jageswar Bora responded to the Questions and doubts raised by the participants.

Finally, Tulashi Rajkhowa, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, Majuli College proposed vote of thanks. He expressed special gratitude to the Resource Person for his informative and useful presentation. He also expressed gratitude to the Principal, Majuli College for his constant encouragement and support in conducting the webinar. He further shared his heartfelt thanks to all the participants of the webinar, teaching and non-teaching staffs of Majuli College to make it a grand success.

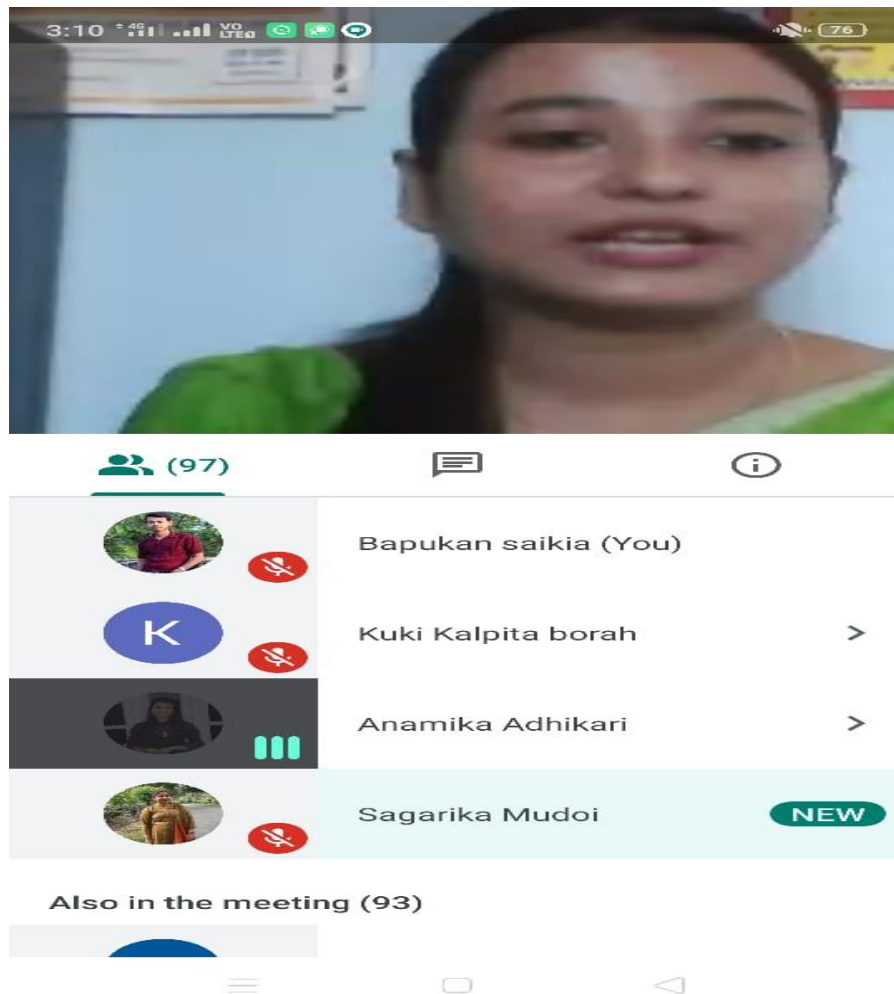

A national webinar was organized by department of Chemistry, Majuli College, in collaboration with IQAC, Majuli College, on 26th Aug, 2020. The topic of the webinar was 'Chemistry of Alcohols'. Prof. Ramesh Chandra Deka, Dean, School of Sciences as well as the Professor, Department of Chemical Sciences, Tezpur University was the resource person of the webinar. The programme was started at 11:00 am with the welcome speech by Dr. Debajyoti Bhattacharjee, Assistant professor, Department of Chemistry, Majuli College. After that, honourable Principal of Majuli College, Dr. Debajit Saikia, formally inaugurated the webinar. Dr. Debajyoti Bhattacharjee, coordinator of the webinar, introduced the resource person to the participants and welcomed him for the technical session. Prof. Deka, then started his speech with the help of a very exciting power point presentation. He first showed some photographs and a video based on Oktoberfest festival of Munich, Germany. He then explained the effects of alcohols in the context of our country. In recent days, alcohol consumption becomes a major social problem in our country. Alcoholism and chronic use of alcohols are associated with numerous medical, psychiatric, social and family problems. According to WHO, alcohols kills

about 2.6 lakhs of Indians every year either by causing liver cirrhosis, cancer or leading to road accidents caused by drunk drivers. In our native state also, we have to frequently hear various tragic incidents related to toxicity of alcohols. Prof. Deka, explained all the harmful chemical aspects relating to alcohol consumption. All alcohols in the human body first converted to acetaldehyde and it then converted into acetic acid radical. Acetaldehyde is a very harmful chemical and can cause significant damage in our body. Organs like liver, gastrointestinal tract, various tissues and even brain can be affected by alcohol metabolism. The acetic acid radical combines with Coenzyme A to form acetyl-CoA. The acetyl CoA then enters into Krebs cycle and broken down to carbon dioxide and water. He also showed serious concerns on growing rate of alcohol consumption among students. He concluded his presentation with the hope that people will aware on the adverse effects of alcohols and our society will be alcohol free.

The students as well as the faculties were highly benefited by the very informative speech of Prof. Ramesh Chandra Deka. In the question answer session, various faculty members and students were shown to clear their doubts relating to the presentation. As a responsible citizen, it is our prime duty to protect our society from all kinds of negative aspects. The webinar seem to benefit the participants by creating awareness on the adverse effects of alcohols. Such type of awareness among students will help to keep them motivated and also encourage them to spread their awareness in society. 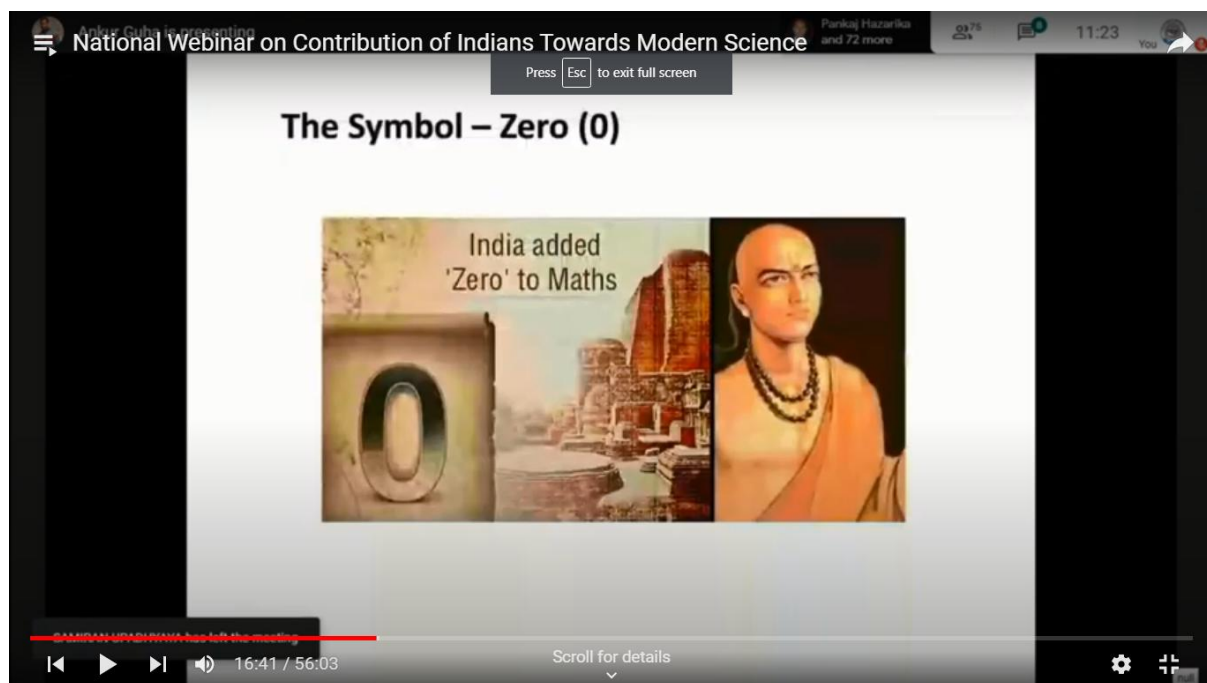

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
